## What We Do With Our Proceeds - “We Serve”

First, the members of the Fayetteville Lions Club sincerely thank all the great fishermen and women for their support for our Projects and our Goals.

The Lion motto is "**We Serve**". All money earned through Lion projects is spent for our service projects, the majority in the local area. Here are just some of the things we do **each year**:

The most important thing that the lions do for the community is **sight and hearing** conservation including:

- Eye exams and purchase of glasses and hearing aids for over 65 Lincoln County citizens in financial need
- Sight and hearing screening for over 2000 students in our local schools and in several health fairs; resulting in many children being referred for vision or hearing problems.
- Photoscreening for eye disease of preschool children, in concert with Vanderbilt Hospital
- Sight problems thus identified can be, and usually are, corrected before they become bigger problems later in life.

We also sponsor a wide variety of youth programs and sports:

- Award 2 to 4 college scholarships each year
- Sponsor Leo Clubs in county and junior high schools
- Sponsor a Drug Awareness Essay Contest awarding 11 \$100 cash awards
- Sponsor a Peace Poster Contest awarding up to 8 \$50 cash awards
- Host a pre-season Football Jamboree for 7th to 9th grade schools
- Host a pre-season Basketball Tournament for 7th to 9th grade schools
- Fund capital improvements to the Lions Sports Complex
- Sponsor six youth baseball & softball teams
- Sponsor a Boys and Girls State delegate and 3 Fairest of the Fair entries

Finally we make significant monetary contributions to state and international Lions programs related to eyesight and health initiatives.
