

Fayetteville Lions Club Fishing for Sight **Bass Tournament Rules**

- 1) You must register, sign release form, and receive a boat number, before blast off. (keep your number see #11 and #12 , you will need to turn in number to be eligible to weigh in fish an for drawing)
- 2) The rules of this tournament shall be interpreted by the director of this event.
- 3) **All Largemouth and Kentucky Bass must measure a minimum of 15” – AGAIN 15” limit on Largemouth or “spots”.
- 4) All Smallmouths must measure a minimum of 18”.
- 5) Tournament Director will measure fish on Golden Rule.
- 6) If a team brings a short fish to the scale the penalty shall be the loss of that fish AND the largest fish in the bag.
- 7) FIVE fish limit per boat!! No culling at ramp.
- 8) Please make every effort to keep fish alive, all fish brought to scales must be released (Except for personal trophy fish).
- 9) DEAD fish will receive a 1 lb penalty for each fish – if BIG fish is dead 1 lb penalty against big fish. All dead fish must shows signs of a recent catch!!
- 10) Artificial lures only
- 11) **ALL boats turn in boat number at 1 of 2 check in pontoon boats (on the water) by 2:00 pm. Any boat not checked in at a pontoon check in boat by 2:00 will NOT be able to weigh fish!! ALSO we will need your number so we can use for \$500 cash drawing. (must be present to win drawing and prizes)
- 12) **Blast off at pontoon with strobe light. Will call boats out 3 at a time 1-2-3 etc. Once they are on plane, will call the next 3 boats 4-5-6 etc. Please line up as close to this order as possible so that we can get every one out ASAP!!
- 13) No drugs or alcohol during tournament or weigh in.
- 14) All anglers must abide by all other TWRA and State laws and regulations while on the water.
