Healthy to Learn Health Fair

On August 11th from 9-11 AM, the Lions participated in the 3rd Annual “Healthy to Learn” Youth Health Fair at the Patrick Rehab/Wellness Center. The Fair is sponsored by Lincoln County Health Council, UT Extension and Lincoln County Health System. Its provides free health screenings, wellness education, refreshments and

fun for children from preschool to Grade 12 to prepare them for 'back to school.'

Leah Mathis represented the Lions conducting sight and hearing screenings, with Lions John Butler and Vince Kearns assisting. There were 35 children screened with 7 of those referred for further sight examination.

District 12S Cabinet Meeting

A total of 91 Lions were present representing 19 Clubs from the District including 13 Presidents and 11 Secretaries. This was the largest attendance on record.

Some highlights from the program:

1. The Contest and Awards program will be divided into small club or large club levels.
2. The District is attempting to secure a grant to acquire a new sight and hearing screening van for the

District. Lions International will consider this grant in April.

3. A report was given on the Tennessee Lions Charities Vision Screening Program. The report included the status of the new Sure Sight Program as well as the fact that 38 of the old cameras are still working and can be used.
4. Attendees were encouraged to consider attendance of the U.S.A./Canada Leadership Forum based on its importance and quality. This year's Forum will be held in September in Grand Rapids, Michigan.
